



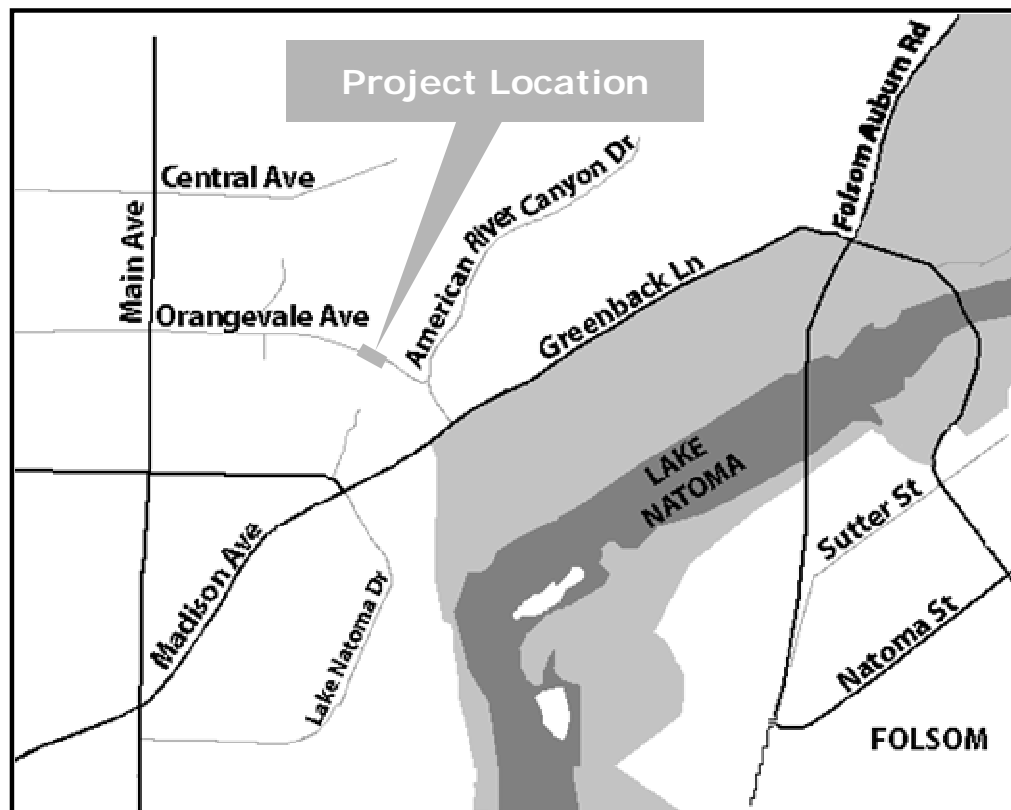
CITY OF FOLSOM PUBLIC WORKSHOP

Repair/Replacement of the Orangevale Avenue Bridge

Thursday, April 22, 2004 - 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.
Folsom Community Center - 52 Natoma Street

The public is invited to a 2nd public workshop to discuss the repair/replacement of the Orangevale Avenue bridge in Folsom. The first meeting was held January 6th, 2004. Comments and responses are posted on the City's website.

The City of Folsom, in coordination with Caltrans and the Federal Highway Administration, will repair or replace the Orangevale Avenue Bridge over Gold Creek. The bridge is located on Orangevale Avenue between American River Canyon Drive and Main Avenue. The existing bridge is a narrow, single lane structure that is not wide enough to meet current safety standards. The new bridge will accommodate two lanes of traffic, bike lanes, and a sidewalk on one side. The project is part of the City's effort to bring older bridges up to current safety standards. Public input is an important part of the process.
